# *International Commercial Arbitration*

## Institutional v. *ad hoc* arbitration

- institutional designates an existing arbitral institution, outside is *ad hoc*
- challenging to locate awards and proceedings because they are usually confidential

WestlawNext: Under “All Content” go to “International Materials,” then the “International Arbitration Materials” link on the right side of the screen.

Note that “Practical Law” includes “International Arbitration” as a practice area. About 45 countries are summarized.

# *Web Translators*

\*Cannot be relied upon to provide a completely accurate, or “official” translation.

- Can be used to get a general sense of a document.
- Generally not designed to incorporate legal meanings of terms.
- Syntax can be problematic.
